Locating: Slots and openings in the cabinet are provided for ventilation to protect it from overheating. Do not block these openings or allow them to be blocked by placing the STB on a bed, sofa, or other similar surface, nor should it be placed over a radiator or heat register.

Power-Cord Protection: Place the power-supply cord out of the way, where it will not be walked on. Please take special attentions to cords at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the unit.

Object and Liquid Entry: Never put objects of any kind into this STB through openings, as they may touch dangerous voltage points or short-out parts that could result in a fire or electric shock. Never spill any liquid on the STB.

Note: Moisture may be formed on the lens in the following conditions:

If the moisture forms inside the unit, it may not operate properly. To correct this problem, turn on the power and wait about two hours for the moisture to evaporate.

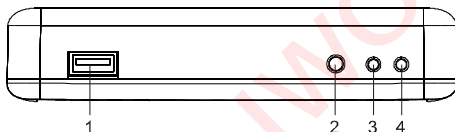

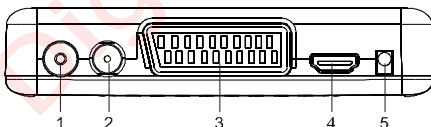

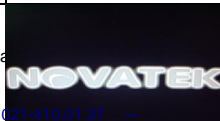

3. Welcome Page

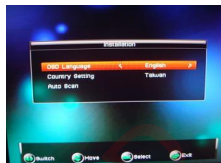
When turning the power on for the first time, the welcome page will be displayed as shown below:

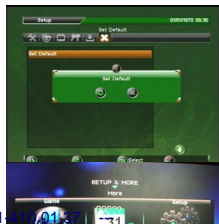

- (3) Press [VOL-/VOL+/CH-/CH+] to select focused item.
- (4) Press [OK] to input current focused symbol or number.
- (5) Press [Red] to get the calculation result

4.3 Game

- (1) Press [CH-/CH+] until switching to "Setup & More" item.
- (2) Press [VOL-/VOL+] until switching to "Game".
- (3) Press [OK] to enter "Game" menu.

4.3.1 box man

5. BROADCASTING

In "Broadcasting" menu, one may select the service type to watch in service mode, including TV, Radio and Recorder.

- (1) Press [Menu] to enter "Main Menu".
- (2) Press [CH-/CH+] until switching to "Broadcasting" item.
- (3) Press [VOL-/VOL+], switching to the wanted service type.
- (4) Press [OK] to watch the service.



5.1 TV&RADIO

Selecting "TV" or "Radio" would enter service mode at once, switching to the specified service. When TV/RADIO playing, Press [Navi] to enable TV/RADIO Navi bar.

5.1.1 TV Guide

"Guide" is usually called EPG (Electronic Program Guide) too. With EPG, user can know the current/future program info of channels, and book the desired program for watching or recording as well.

- (1) Press [Navi] to enable Navi bar in service mode.
- (2) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select "TV Guide" item.
- (3) Press [OK] to enter the "Guide" menu.

Pressing [EPG] in service mode can enter the "Guide" menu directly



5.1.2 TV LIST

- (1) Press [Navi] to enable the "List" Navi bar.
- (2) Press [CH-/CH+] to select "TV List" item.

5.1.2.1 Service list

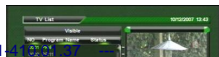
Service list*: List the channels as different groups, including visible, invisible (skip) and favorites.

- (1) Press [Green] to focus on channel group selecting bar.
- (2) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to switch between groups.
- (3) Press [OK] to enter the list of current selected group.



5.1.2.2 Service Status

"Service Status": Current channel status info would be displayed in small video window on top-right screen,



such as “No Signal”

5.1.2.3 Favorites

“Favorite”: User may group the channels into eight pre-defined favorites groups, including “Music”, “Sports”, “Shopping”, “Traffic”, “Movie”, “News”, “Fav1” and “Fav2”.

- (1) Press [Navi] to enable the “List” Navi bar.
- (2) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select “Favorite” item.
- (3) Press [CH-/CH+] to select the channel to FAV.
- (4) Press [OK] to show favorite groups.
- (5) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select the group.
- (6) Press [OK] to set current channel to current group.
- (7) Press [Yellow/Exit] to save the setting.



5.1.2.4 LOCK

Lock: If “Channel Lock” is “ON” and a channel is set to “Lock”, user is required to input the password when watching the locked channel. See chapter 4.1.4(2) for “Channel Lock” setting.

- (1) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select “Lock” item.
- (2) Press [CH-/CH+] to select the channel to lock.
- (3) Press [OK] to lock/unlock the channel.
- (4) Press [Yellow/Exit] to save the setting.



5.1.2.5 Edit

- (1) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select “Edit” item.
- (2) Press [OK] to enter program info page.
- (3) Press [OK] to load keyboard page for channel name modification.
- (4) Press [VOL-/VOL+/CH+/CH-/OK] to modify channel name.
- (5) Press [Exit] to return program info page.
- (6) Pressing [Exit], message box to confirm saving would be displayed



5.1.2.6 MOVE

- (1) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select “Move” item
- (2) Press [CH-/CH+] to select the channel to move.
- (3) Press [OK] to set the selected channel to “Move” status.
- (4) Press [CH-/CH+] to move the channel in list.



- (5) Press[OK] to confirm the target channel position.
- (6) Press[OK] to confirm save and [Exit]to cancel save

5.1.2.7 Sort

User may sort the channels in this Navi bar.

The channels are sorted by name (A-Z), Pay-Free or TP.

- (1) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select "Sort" item.
- (2) Press [OK] to display sort types.
- (3) Press [CH-/CH+] to select the sort type.
- (4) Press [OK] to sort the channels.
- (5) Press [OK] to confirm sorting save and [Exit] to cancel save

5.1.2.8 Skip

- (1) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select "Skip" item.
- (2) Press [Ch+/Ch-] to select the channel to skip.
- (3) Press[OK] to set the channel to skip state.
- (4) Press [Yellow/Exit] to save the setting.
- (5) Press [OK] to confirm save and [Exit] to cancel save.

5.1.2.9 Delete

- (1) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select "Delete" item.
- (2) Press [OK] to display delete types.
- (3) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select delete type.
- (4) Press [OK] to set current channle to "Delete" state.
- (5) Press [Yellow/Exit] to save the setting.
- (7) Press [OK]to confirm save and [Exit] to cancel save.

- (1) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select "Search" item.
- (2) Press [OK] to display search types.

- (6) Press [Exit] to return "List" page.
- (8) Press [VOL-/VOL+]to select search direction (type), "Next" or "Previous".
- (9) Press <OK> to start searching.

- (1) Press [Navi] to enable the "subtitle" Navi bar.

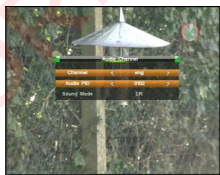

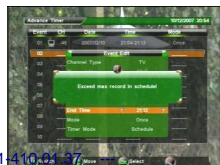
5.1.8 Advance Timer

- (1) Press [CH-/CH+] to select a blank booking.
- (2) Press [OK] to enter "Event Edit" menu.
- (3) Press [CH-/CH+] to focus on "Channel Type" bar.
- (4) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select the booking channel type, including TV and Radio.



- (5) Press [CH-/CH+] to focus on "Channel No" bar.
- (6) Press [VOL-/VOL+] or [0~9] to input booking channel number.
- (7) Press [CH-/CH+] to focus on "Start Date" bar.
- (8) Press [0~9] to input booking start date (year/month/day).
- (9) Press [CH-/CH+] to focus on "Start Time" bar.
- (10) Press [0~9] to input booking start time (hour/min, in 24 hour format).
- (11) Press [CH-/CH+] to focus on "End Time" bar.
- (12) Press <0~9> to input booking end time (hour/min, in 24 hour).
- (13) Press [CH-/CH+] to focus on "Mode" bar.
- (14) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select booking mode, including Stop, Once, Daily, Weekly, Weekend day and Weekday.
- (15) Press [CH-/CH+] to focus on "Mode" bar.
- (16) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select event timer mode.
- (17) Press [OK] to save. Press [Exit] to exit event editing menu without saving

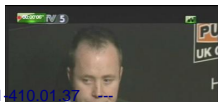
- (1) Press [CH-/CH+] to select a non-blank booking.

5.1.9 channel list

5.1.9.1 Instant Record

- (1) Press [Record] to enter record duration setting page.
- (2) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to set record duration (15 minutes to 8 hours).
- (3) Press [OK] to start instant record.
- (4) Press [stop] to stop instant record.
- (5) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select "Yes" or "No".
- (6) Press [OK] to confirm the selection. "Yes" would



stop current recording and “No” would exit the message box and continue to record

5.1.9.2 Timeshift

To use timeshift function, “Timeshift” should be turned on at first. See chapter 5.1.7.1 for details.

- (1) Timeshift is implemented by recording channel
- (2) data in timeshift data buffer on storage device.
- (3) The function is enabled only if there is storage device plugged-in STB, with a minimum 512Mbytes free disk size.
- (4) Timeshift data is recorded to several files in circle mode. When data buffer is full, the oldest recording file would be deleted to free space for new one. While, if the oldest recording file is in playback, its next file would be deleted instead. In this condition, playback may lost some data.
- (5) If “Timeshift” is set to “AUTO”, timeshift would start automatically after entering service mode. If “Timeshift” is set to “PAUSE”, timeshift would start by pressing [Pause].
- (6) If user wants to keep timeshift content permanently, “timeshift to record” function may be used, transferring timeshift data to record format



5.2 Recorder

“Recorder”: User can play and manage the recorded services here.

- (1) Press [VOL-/VOL+] until switching to “Recorder”.
- (2) Press [OK] to enter “My Recorder” menu.

5.21 MY Recorder

In “My Recorder” menu, user can manage the recorder. And through Navi bar, five sub-functions are provided, including “Edit”, “Vol”, “Del”, “Device” and “Option”

- (1) Press [Navi] to enable recorder Navi bar.
 - (2) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select Navi bar item
- In “Edit” item, name of record can be modified.

In keyboard UI, [VOL-/VOL+/CH-/CH+] are used to edit the new name. And pressing [Exit] would exit current



editing and save the new name

(3) In "Vol" item, current volume can be read/set through a displayed volume bar. Pressing [Exit] would exit the current Navi bar item.

(4) Selecting "Del" Navi bar item, system would ask whether to delete the selected files. Press [OK] to confirm and [Exit] to cancel. Before deleting, user should use

"Enable Arrow Key" item to select the target files

(5) In "Device" item, user can view and manage all storage devices, which are currently plugged-in the STB

(6) "Option" item corresponds to PVR related settings



5.21.1 Play Records\

In "My Recorder" menu, user can select the record to play.

(1) Press [VOL-/VOL+/CH-/CH+] to view and select records.

(2) Press [OK] to preview the selected record in the small video window on bottom-right screen.

(3) Press [Yellow] to play the selected record in full screen.



5.22.2 Navi for Record Playing

When playing record, press [Navi] can enter record playing navigation bar, providing functional items of "File", "Step", "Vol", "Zoom+", "Zoom-", "Info" and "Option".

(1) When playing record, press [Navi] to load recorder Navi bar.

(2) Press [VOL-/VOL+] to select Navi bar item.

(3) Select "File" item would return to "My Recorder" menu.

(4) In "Step" item, every [OK] pressing would cause current playing moves forward by one-step. Press [OK] can return to normal play speed.

(5) In "Vol" item, current volume can be read/set through a displayed volume bar. Pressing [Exit] would exit volume adjust.

(6) "Zoom+/Zoom-" item provides video output zoom in function.

(7) Pressing [OK] would switch between 75%, 50% and 25% modes. Pressing [Exit] would exit the function.

(8) When playing record, user may select "Info" item to see the related record info.

6.1 Music

Focusing on "Main Menu" -> "MULTIMEDIA" -> "Music", press [OK] to enter "Music Thumbnail's file manager mode" page. Press [Exit] to enter music thumbnail. If the focused item is playable folder or file press [Yellow] start play music. Press [Menu] to exit the Music Thumbnail" page and return to "Main Menu"

6.1.1 Top option

Press [Green] key to focus on "Top Option" item after finishing file information display in the "Music Thumbnail", And if the focused item is "Top Option", it will change the focused item to "Thumbnail" when [Green] or [Exit] key is pressed.

- (1) Select "repeat mode"
- (2) Select "random mode"
- (3) Focusing on "exit & play" sub-item of "Top Option", pressing [OK] would enter music play page

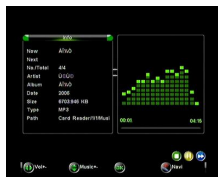

"Movie Play" screen can be entered by pressing [Yellow] key in "Movie Thumbnail" or choose "Exit & play" in "Top Option" Press [Red] to play backward in trick mode. The modes include "X2", "X4", "X8", "X16", "X32", "X1/2", "X1/4" and "X1" Press [Green] to stop playing movie.

Press [Yellow] to pause/resume playing.

Press [Blue] to play forward in trick mode. The modes include "X2", "X4", "X8", "X16", "X32", "X1/2", "X1/4" and "X1" Press <Navi> to display/hide the Navi bar.

8. Troubleshooting

If you encounter problems when using this unit, check the following points before requesting service.

Problem	Solution
No Power	Please: Confirm that you have an appropriate power source Check if all connections between wall outlet and power supply, and power supply and the player are correct. Switch power button on front of the player to turn on the power
Buttons do not work	To completely reset the player, unplug the AC cord from the AC outlet for 5-10 seconds.
The player does not respond to the remote control	Point the remote control towards the remote receiver. Make sure the signal from the remote control to the receiver on the player is not blocked by solid objects. Reduce the distance to the media player. Replace the batteries in the remote control. Re-insert the batteries with their polarities (+/- signs) as

	indicated.
No Picture	Check if the TV is switched on. Select the appropriate video input on your TV
No sound or distorted sound	Adjust the volume. Check the audio cables are connected correctly. Select the audio output that is supported by your TV.
